

2021 MĀWHITIPANA MARSANNE

Our Marsanne vintages are produced from a blend of the block across the Estate and Ridge sides of the vineyard. Marsanne is a unique and rare variety, only found in a few vineyards on Waiheke, and originates from the Rhône valley in Southern France, thriving in Waiheke's Mediterranean like environment.

The 2021 Māwhitipana Marsanne had a run as dreamy as its origins. This vintage was long, calm and dry. A long hot season with little rain produced small berries and low yields with lots of concentration. A settled harvest produced ideal picking conditions.

The Māwhitipana Marsanne is a seamless, full bodied wine that flows beautifully into a smooth finish, with notes of burnt orange rind. An inviting nose of oriental spice, including cloves and dried citrus peel with notes of honeysuckle. A wine as dreamy as its sustainable origins.

A limited vintage with only 48 cases produced, release February 2023.
