Nockie's Palette Pinot Gris 2023 Waitaki, North Otago



WINEMAKING NOTES

This Pinot Gris is grown on the Tatty Bogler Vineyard just East of Kurow in the Waitaki Valley.

The grapes were hand-picked on the 25th April 2023 at just over 21 Brix showing classic varietal character and a generosity commensurate with the warmer growing

Whole Bunch Pressed and cold settled for 48 hours before racking to old barrels for fermentation with a neutral yeast strain. The wine remained on full yeast lees post fermentation for 4 months to build subtle complexity and additional texture. The combination of regional and varietal expression is balanced in equal measure by gentle winemaking to produce a wine with abundant flavour, texture and layers of complexity.

> This wine will develop further over the next 2 to 3 years.

COLOUR

Lemon.

NOSE

Harmonious bouquet of green pear, quince, white peach, cut grass, candied lemon and subtle notes of honey.

PALATE

Dry medium-bodied Pinot Gris with the characteristical refreshing acidity of the Waitaki Valley. Fresh flavours of green fruits (pear, apple) and citrus (lemon) are completed by a saline finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Siu Mai or Thai cuisine.
