GROWING SEASON (2024) W

What a difference a year makes. After the weather events in '23, it was great to see a long hot and sun-drenched season. All in all, at the Jasper, we had a great vintage with stunning high quality fruit for the '24 rosé winemaking.

VINEYARD

Jasper Ridge Estate is located at the east end of New Zealand's Waiheke Island on Cowes Bay Road, near the small coastal settlement of Orapiu, overlooking the Hauraki Gulf. It is a single variety (Syrah) vineyard that is home to around 4000 vines, with rosé grapes harvested from the bottom and shed blocks to form the basis of the Jasper Ridge Rosé '24.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested on 25 March '24, the fruit was destemmed and gently pressed for a couple of hours, creating a pink hue. To retain the fruit flavours, the grapes were cold-fermented in stainless steel tanks for 14 days until nearly dry. The wine was bottled in June 2024.

TASTING NOTES

A vibrant, pink rosé crafted from handpicked Waiheke Island grapes. The red berry aromas take centre stage with crisp, juicy summer strawberry flavours and a refreshing dry finish.
