Pinot Noir is at the heart of Foxes Island with the first vintage produced in 1993.

The Belsham Awatere Estate is hand-tended, and organically and sustainably farmed with a focus on fostering healthy bio-diversity and natural yeast populations.

The 2013 indigenous ferment, is a stylish wine with strong lines and soft curves. Generous yet refined layers unfold their complexities slowly and methodically in the glass. Aromas of rose and ripe cherries lead to ripe dark fruit flavours underscored by savoury herbs, oyster shell and spicy oak that are long and sumptuous.
