## **2022 CARRICK ARTHUR PINOT NOIR**

Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

This single-block, single clone wine is named for the couple who established this Bannockburn vineyard, Sue and Bill Arthur. The northwest-facing aspect and the silty loam soils combine with the own-rooted old vines to carry a unique sense of place into this limited production wine.

Carrick

Hand-picked and sorted in the vineyard, 100% 10/5 clone from 26 year old vines. De-stemmed to tank, fermented wild using a combination of pump-overs and punch-downs to manage the cap. On skins for 17 days, pressed, settled, and racked to barrels - for 10 months, 23% new.
